Re: Transportation Workers Identification Credential (TWIC)

Young Brothers has been keeping our customers apprised of the implementation of the federal government's TWIC program. This is the requirement, for those wishing to enter a YB facility at least once a week and have unescorted access, to enroll and obtain a TWIC card. The TSA has now announced that the implementation of the TWIC program will take place in Hawaii in February 2009. The exact implementation date is not yet known, but we expect to know a firm start-up date in October or November 2008. After the start-up date, there will no longer be automatic entry into a YB facility if the people do not have a TWIC card.
