Re: Urgent Security Matter

The Transportation Workers Identification Credential (TWIC) requirement will be implemented on **Thursday, February 12th**. Young Brothers has been keeping our customers informed about this requirement for over a year and the time has arrived. All customers, who come to a YB facility one or more times per week, need to have a TWIC in order to have unescorted access to YB facilities when conducting business. The TWIC will be checked at the entry gate when you come to a facility.

Customers who do not have a TWIC will be subject to a monitoring system that YB will put into place on February 12th. This will require customers entering a facility to leave their driver's license with the security officer in exchange for a colored cone that will be placed on your vehicle to designate that you do not have a TWIC. Your activities, while on the facility, will be monitored by security and YB employees. Upon completing your business, you will get your license back when the cone is returned to security.

These steps are taken to be in compliance with the federal regulations under the Maritime Transportation Security Act. Periodically the Coast Guard will inspect facilities and check the TWIC cards of those on the facility, including customers, to make sure they are valid.
