**Department of Transportation Wharfage Fee Increase
Effective July 1, 2010**

As previously advised in a letter dated February 24, 2010 (see attachment), the State of Hawaii Department of Transportation, Harbors Division (DOT) will be increasing wharfage and other fees on the 1st of July each year. The DOT uses these fees to operate the State's commercial harbors, and to fund harbor improvements. Because Young Brothers is required to collect the DOT's wharfage fees, it will appear as a line item on your invoice. Young Brothers will then transmit the collected fees to the DOT.

Below are some common wharfage fees and their upcoming increases. Standard Automobiles per port:

\$ 11.55	\$ 13.86
